Ways to reduce your Council Tax

Discounts

- One adult resident, a 25% discount may apply
- Some adults can be disregarded, which may result in a discount
- Unoccupied and unfurnished properties;

Period property is empty	Discount applied (% full charge payable)
1-7 days	100% discount (0%)
7 days – 6 months	40% discount (60%)
6 months – 2 years	No discount (100%)
Over 2 years	100% premium (200%)
Over 5 years	200% premium (300%)
Over 10 years	300% premium (400%)

- Uninhabitable property or undergoing structural works – 50% discount may apply up to 12 months
- A reduction may apply if a resident is disabled and uses a wheelchair inside, or the home has certain features required by them.

Exemptions

Some properties are exempt from Council Tax. The length of the exemption that may apply varies depending on the circumstances.

Council Tax Reduction (CTR) Scheme

You may get help if you have a low income and savings under £16,000; or receive Pension Credit.

Time limited reductions: some discounts and exemptions are time limited, including those for empty property. This means they will end after a certain period and the new council tax charge will become due. If your bill shows one of these, a revised bill will be issued when it is due to end.

Budget information - Financial information about Council Tax including Harrogate Borough Council, North Yorkshire County Council, North Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Authority, and Police & Crime Commission expenditure is available at online at www.harrogate.gov.uk/counciltax. To request a free hard copy, please contact us.

Changes of circumstance – You must notify us within 21 days of any change in circumstance that might affect your liability. If you fail to do so you may be subject to a £70 penalty. CTR changes may result in you having more council tax to pay.

Council Tax bands – these are set by the Valuation Office Agency (VOA). If you think your council tax band is wrong you can find out more about what you can do at www.gov.uk/challenge-council-tax-band. If you challenge your band, you must continue to pay council tax at your current band until your appeal is decided.

You can contact the VOA at www.gov.uk/contact-voa. If you are unable to use the online service you can also contact the VOA on 03000 501 501

Council Tax appeals – we will try to resolve any problem that you have but you can formally appeal if you think you should not be liable for Council Tax or we have billed you for the wrong period. You can also appeal if you believe a discount, exemption or disabled band reduction should apply that has been refused. You can also appeal decisions regarding a claim for Council Tax Reduction.

£150 Energy bills rebate - Eligible households in Band A-D who pay their Council Tax by Direct Debit will receive a £150 payment automatically. Those paying by other methods will be invited to provide payment details securely. Owners of second homes and empty properties are not eligible. No payments will be made until after 1 April 2022. Adult social care – this is collected for North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) to help fund adult social care services. Legally we have to show 2% increase on the bill. The amount is 2% increase on last year's NYCC council tax charge, then added to the previous year's adult social care amount. For further detail please visit www.harrogate.gov.uk/counciltax

Data Protection - Any information you give us will be held securely and in accordance with the rules on data protection. We will treat personal details as private and confidential, and safeguard them. We will not disclose them to anyone unconnected with the council unless you have consented to their release or in certain circumstances where;

- we are legally obliged to do so;
- disclosure is necessary for the proper discharge of our statutory functions or to enable us to provide you with a requested service or deal with your enquiry;
- we are under a duty to protect public funds

We may use the information you have provided for the prevention and detection of fraud. We may also share this information with other bodies responsible for public funds or for auditing them for these purposes.

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
